

## Search the Tobian-English Dictionary

- On **opening screen**, click on a letter of the alphabet and you'll see a list of all the Tobian words beginning with that letter. Then click on any word for the full entry.
- At any time, click on **Home** and you'll be returned to that opening screen.
- Or pick one of the buttons on the left side: Search, Tobian, English, Categories, Part of Speech.
  - **Search** button: search for **man** in all languages. You get definitions and examples.



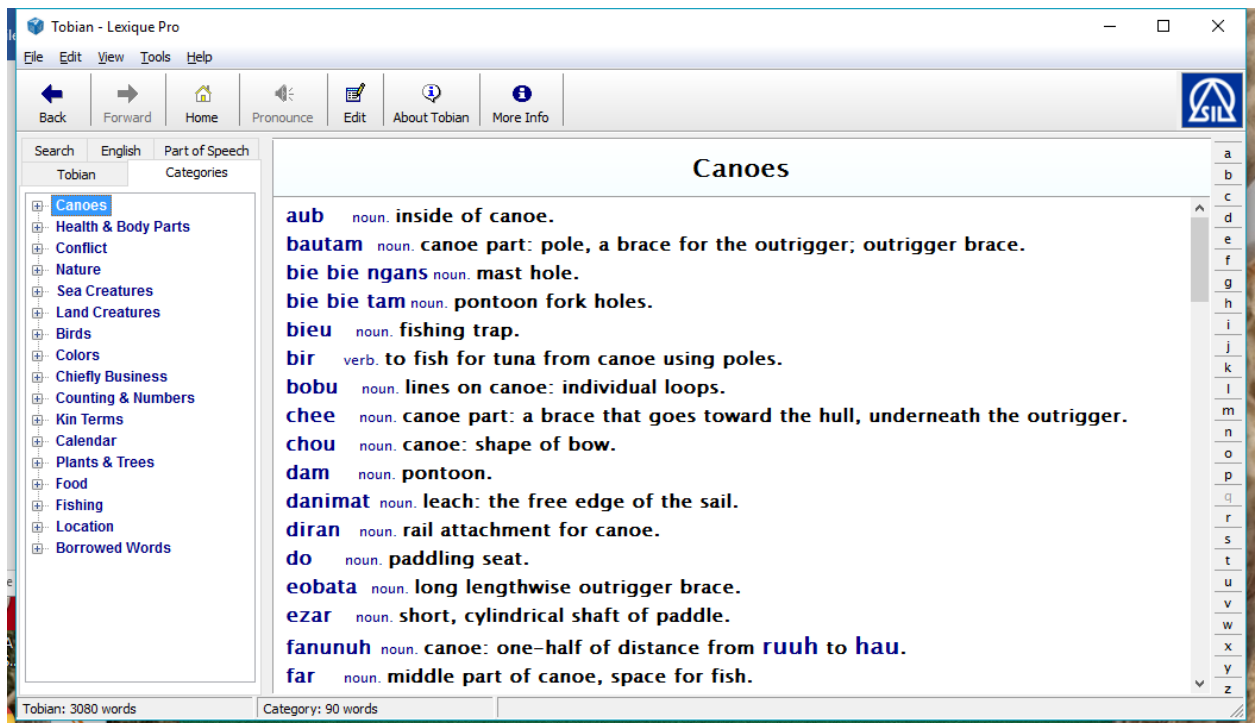

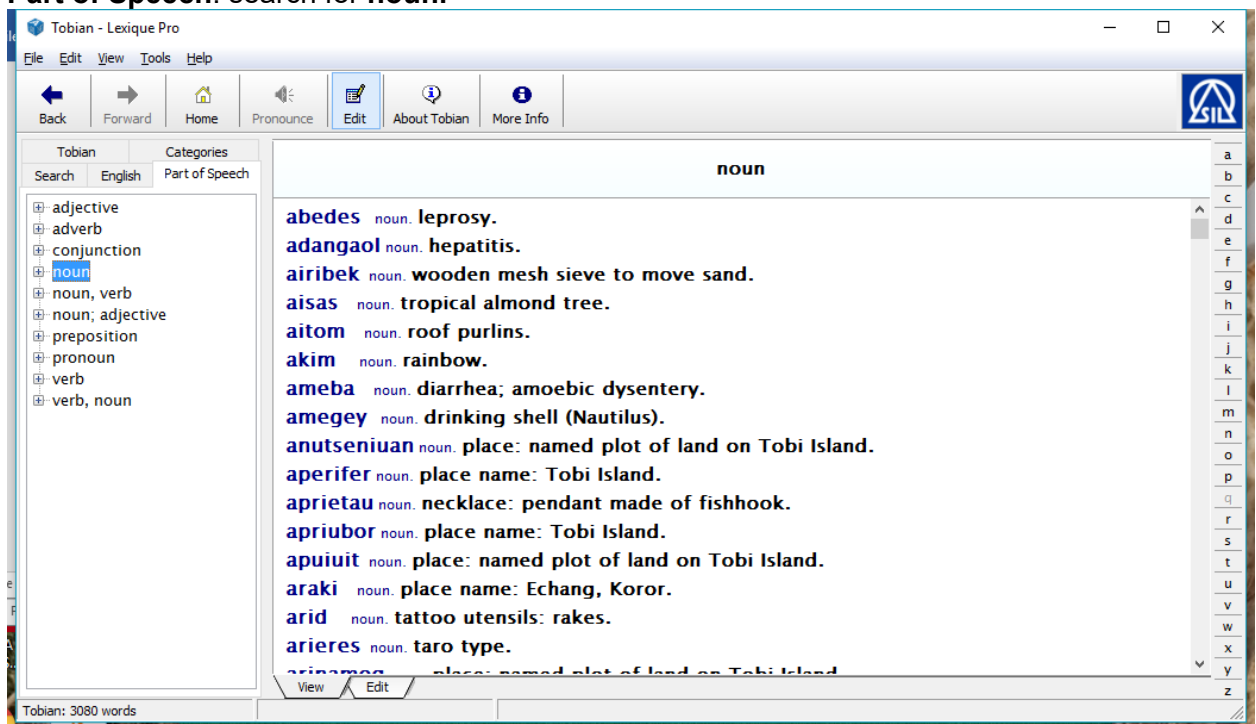
